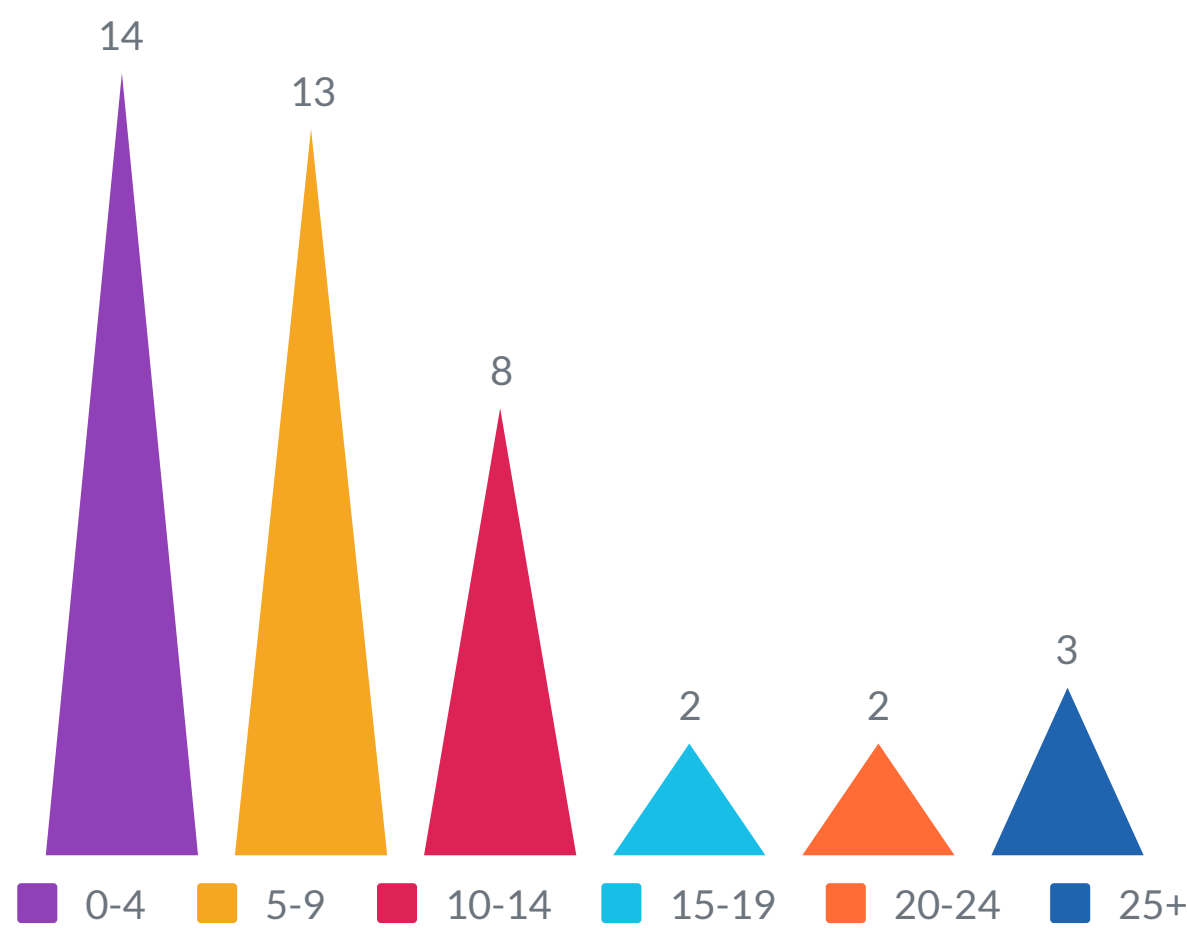


# Simons Searchlight Registry Update ASXL3 (Bainbridge- Ropers Syndrome)

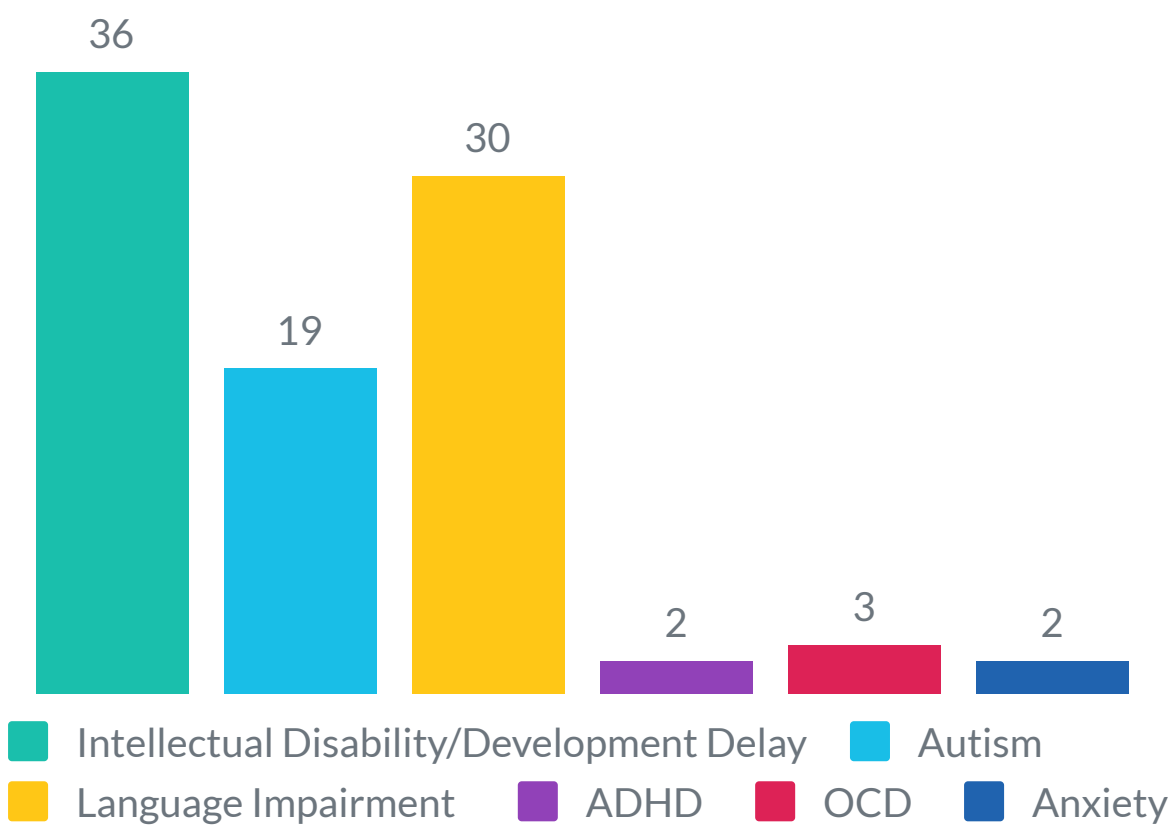

Data in these four graphs are from the medical history phone interviews collected in Simons Searchlight on 42 participants with Bainbridge-Ropers Syndrome (BRS)

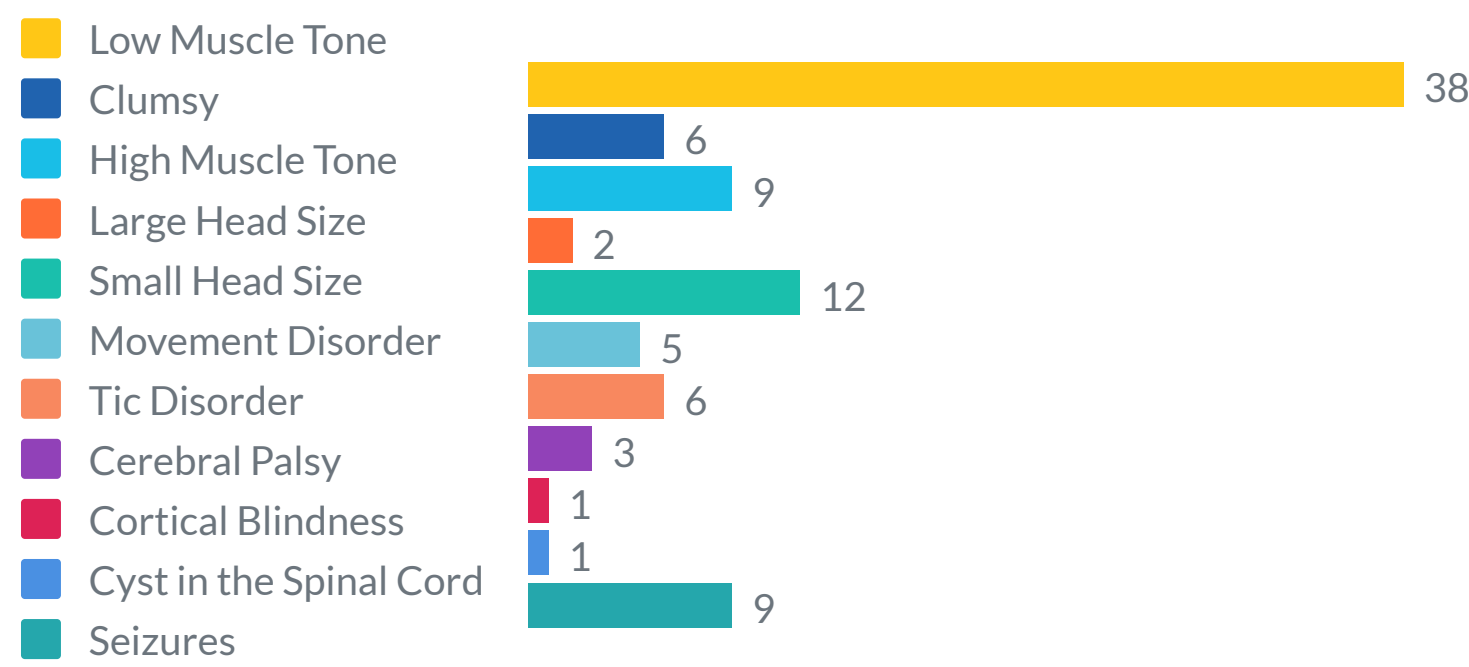
## Ages in Years



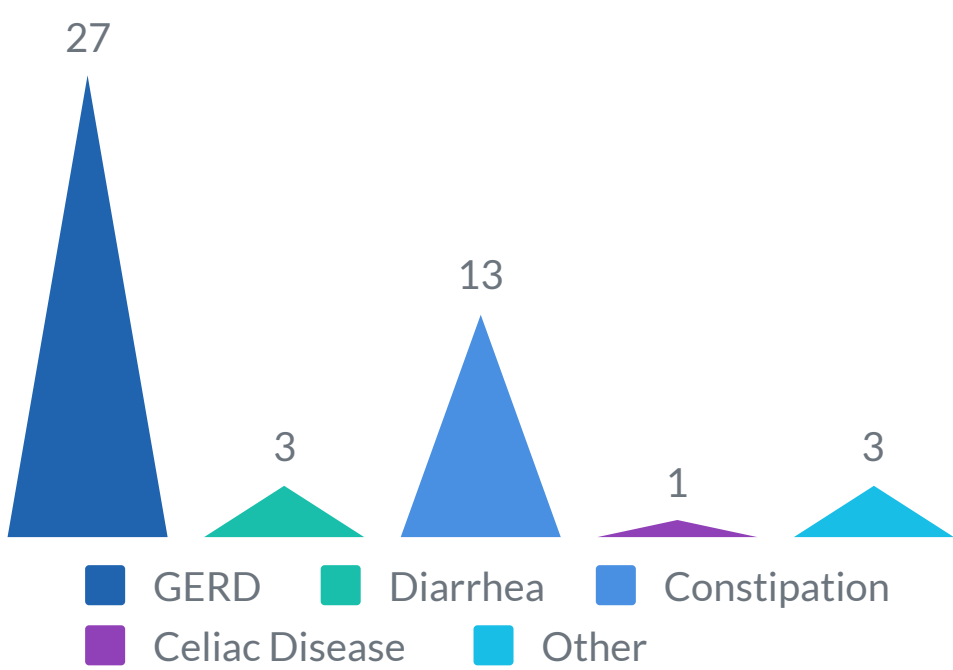
## Developmental & Behavioral Diagnoses

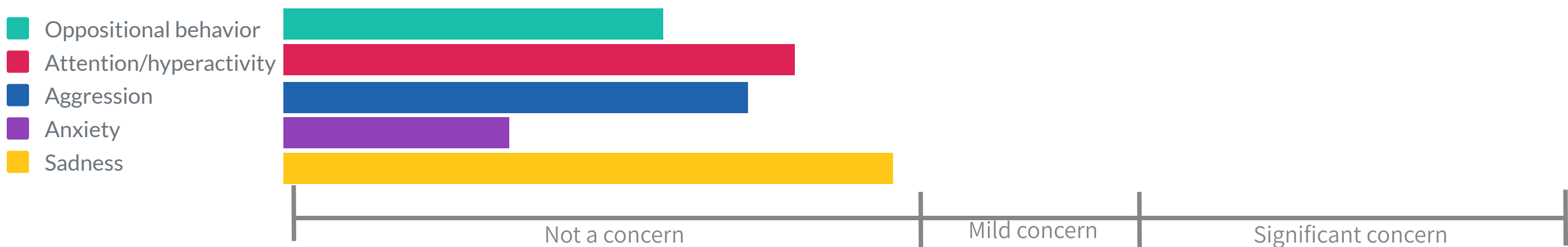


# Information Spotlight: Child Behavior Checklist

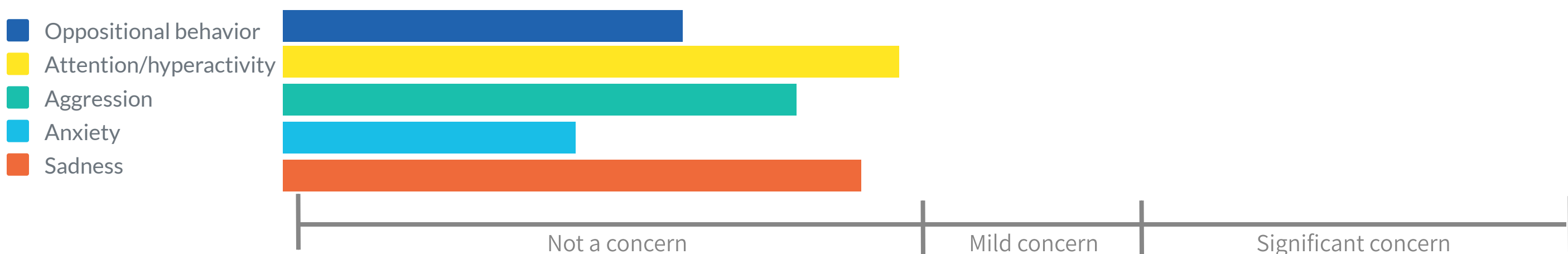
“ The Child Behavior Checklist (CBCL) is a survey used to understand behavioral and emotional concerns in children. ”

The bars in the graphs show the overall level of concern reported by Simons Searchlight caregivers who completed the CBCL survey about their children with BRS. Individual caregivers may have indicated a lower or higher level of concern than indicated by the overall group.

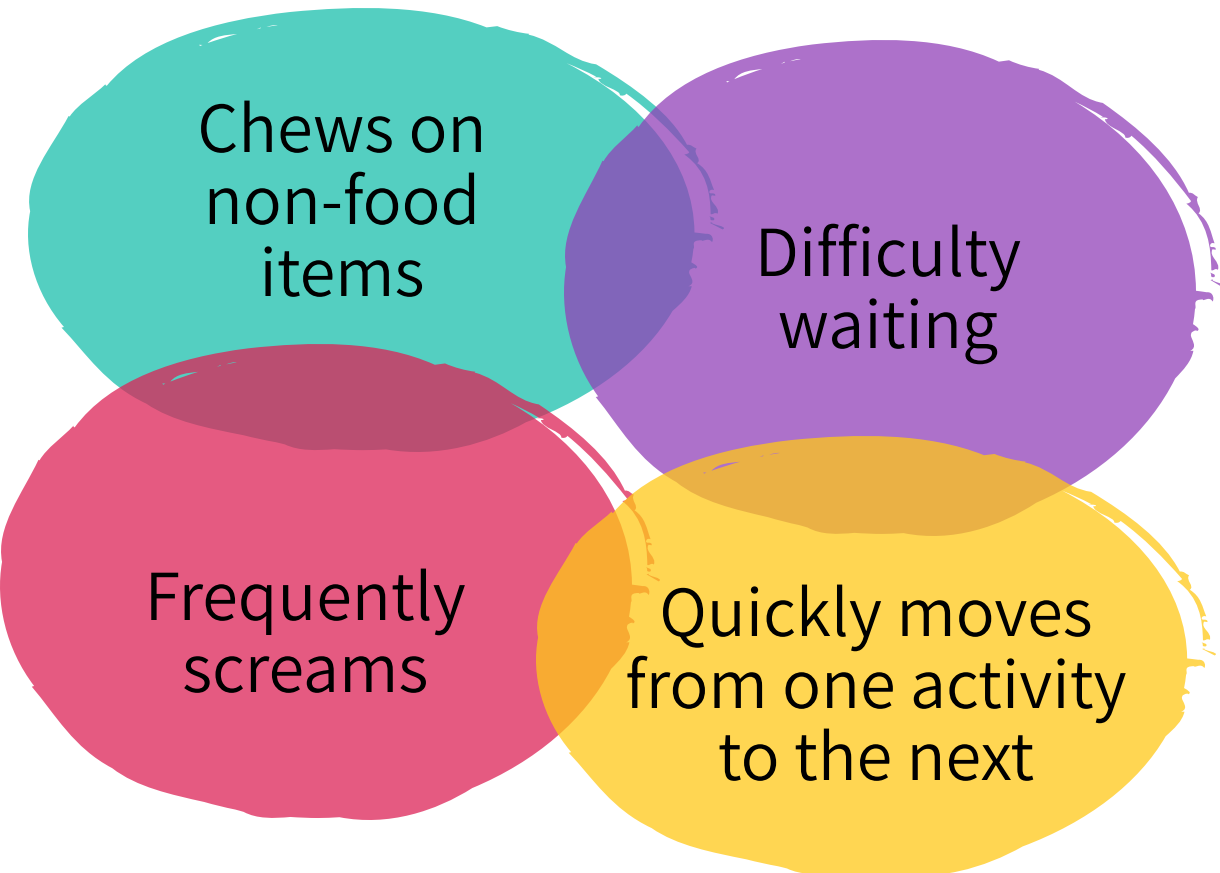
## Behavioral Concerns for ages 1.5-5yrs
